Care
Instructions



- 1 Herbal Oil** Oil wax mixture
2 White herbal oil Special oil wax mixture for maple and oak surfaces
3 Furniture soap For cleaning oiled wood surfaces
4 Countertop oil Especially for kitchen counter tops and heavily used surfaces (e.g. table tops)
5 Palm wax for drawers that stick
6 Scouring pad Removes blemishes from oil wax surfaces
7 Woolen cloth For applying the herbal oil or final polish

CLEANING



For cleaning lightly soiled areas please use warm water, the furniture soap and the woollen cloth (not too damp).



Please treat heavily soiled or stained areas on the table or chair legs with a herbal oil-soaked, non-metallic scouring pad, rubbing in the direction of the grain and applying only slight pressure. Polish with the TEAM 7 woollen cloth. To avoid differences in color, rub on a large area (cir. 20 cm around the blemish).



Polish with the TEAM 7 woollen cloth to remove the excess oil.

Please do not use microfibre cloths, fat-dissolving agents or steam cleaners.

KITCHEN COUNTERTOPS



As described above! Please use only TEAM 7 countertop oil (no herbal oil). The countertop oil penetrates deep into the wood and protects the surfaces during heavy use.



Soak the non-metallic scouring pad with the countertop oil and remove stains, grease spots or other blemishes.



After about 15-20 minutes.



Polish with the TEAM 7 woollen cloth.

Please do not use microfibre cloths, fat-dissolving agents or steam cleaners.

CARE



To care for and polish up the surfaces (every 0,5 – 3 years) apply the TEAM 7 herbal oil thinly and sparingly with a woollen cloth.



Polish with a dry TEAM 7 woollen cloth to remove excess oil.

Please do not use microfibre cloths, fat-dissolving agents or steam cleaners.



Heavily used surfaces (e.g.: table tops): Apply countertop oil as described above more frequently (3-6 months).

REPAIRING SMALL SCRATCHES



Sand the surface with 120-grain sandpaper, rubbing on a large area in the direction of the grain, until the scratch can no longer be seen. Before applying oil, sand the surface to a fine finish, beginning with 150-grain sandpaper, progressing to 180-grain and ending with 240-grain.



Generously apply the TEAM 7 herbal oil with a woolen cloth.



After about 15-20 minutes.



Polish with the TEAM 7 woollen cloth to remove the excess oil.

Please do not use microfibre cloths, fat-dissolving agents or steam cleaners.

REPAIRING DENTS



Lightly sand the dent.



Wet the damaged area, and place a damp cloth over it. Then place a steam iron above the cloth and steam the damaged area through the cloth. The cloth must be sufficiently damp and the iron must not come into direct contact with the wood. Repeat as often as necessary.



When the wood fibers have swollen up and the area is completely dry, sand the treated area flat finishing beginning with 150-grain sandpaper, progressing to 180-grain and ending with 240-grain.



Apply TEAM 7 herbal oil generously with a clean, dry woolen cloth.



After about 15-20 minutes.



Polish with a dry TEAM 7 woollen cloth to remove excess oil.

Please do not use microfibre cloths, fat-dissolving agents or steam cleaners.

Please note: All oil-soaked cloths and scouring pads can be combustible. All used, oil soaked cloths and pads should be rinsed thoroughly with water and disposed of in non-flammable containers. **DANGER OF SPONTANEOUS COMBUSTION!** See advice on bottle.
